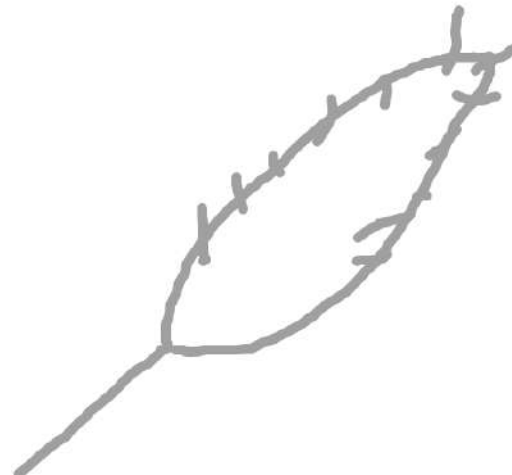

Voting in apache

minimum of three votes

more +1 than -1

In CloudStack we are even more focussed on consensus than that.



projects vs products

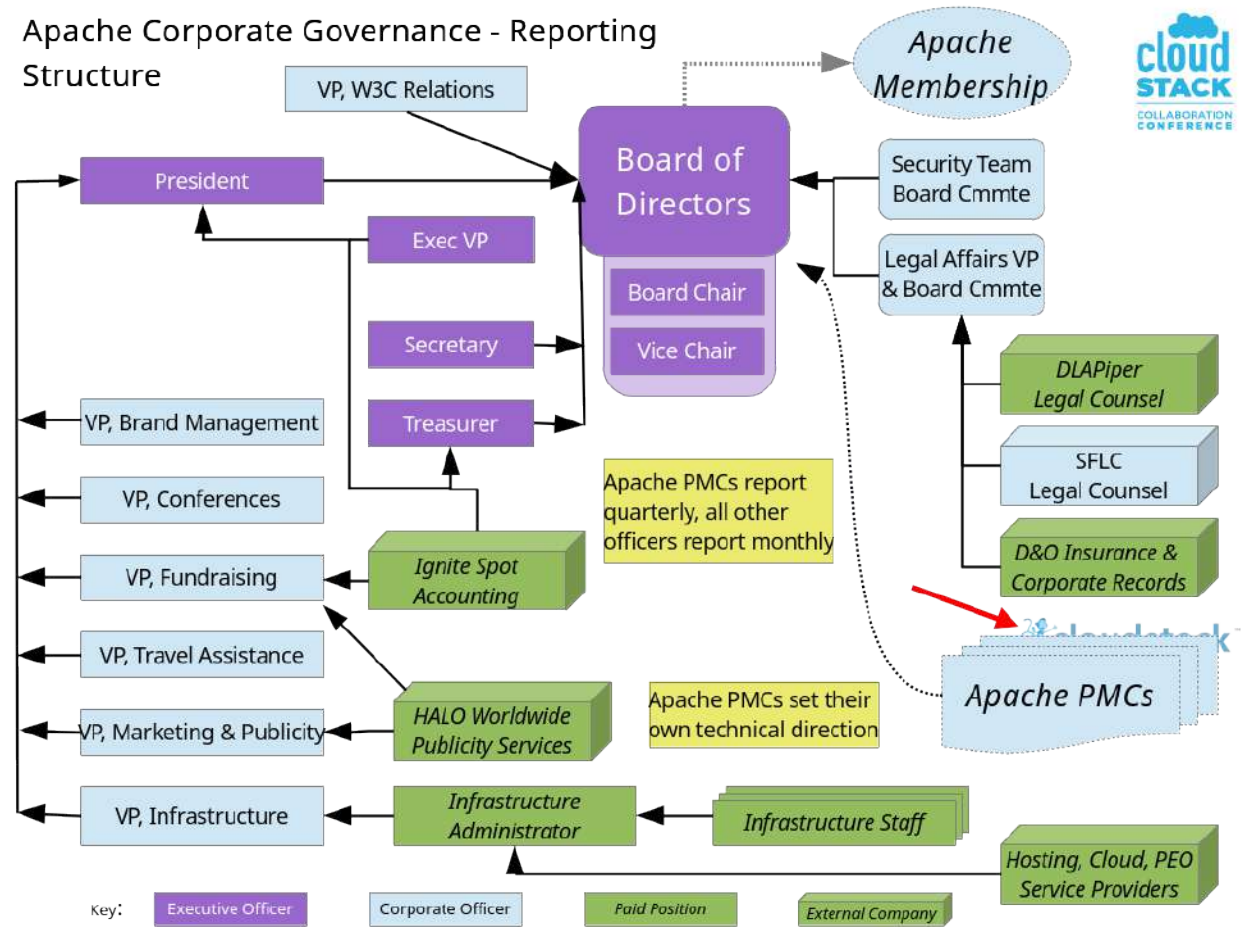
It is the objectives of the foundation to maintain and deliver projects

In turn, it is up to the projects to deliver releases, i.e. half-products
projects often deliver installable packages as extra service.
(as do companies ;)

Apache Corporate Governance - Reporting Structure



everything is a project

Cloudstack is a toplevel project like

- httpd
- tomcat
- airflow
- ... 300+ others

but also projects are

- marketing
- public relations
- infra
- ... some others.

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(Apache) Cloudstack, prehistory

Before, when animals still could speak ; <https://www.cloud.com/>

- launched as VMops in 2010
- rebranded as cloud.com in 2010
- bought by Citrix in July 2011 and released as 2.x
- made open source by citrix as releases 3.y

after  his

- Citrix continued to develop CitrixCloudPlatform as a commercial fork of the project.
- CloudPlatform was sold to Accelerite in January 2016
- neither of these companies are now involved in the CloudStack project
- Accelerite continues to support their latest release 4.15, but no updates so far



Cloudstack(4), Genesis

Donated by citrix and accepted by apache in April 2012 as an incubator project

Incubator projects at apache

- have to prove they have a community behind them

Cloudstack4, Genesis (continued)

and when all requirements are met (in march 2013),

https://cloudstack.apache.org/blog/the_apache_software_foundation_announces/ Apache CloudStack is promoted from the incubator to a TLP, a Top Level Project.

(remember projects vs products (but also projects vs projects))



Voting

So in Cloudstack;
minimum of three votes

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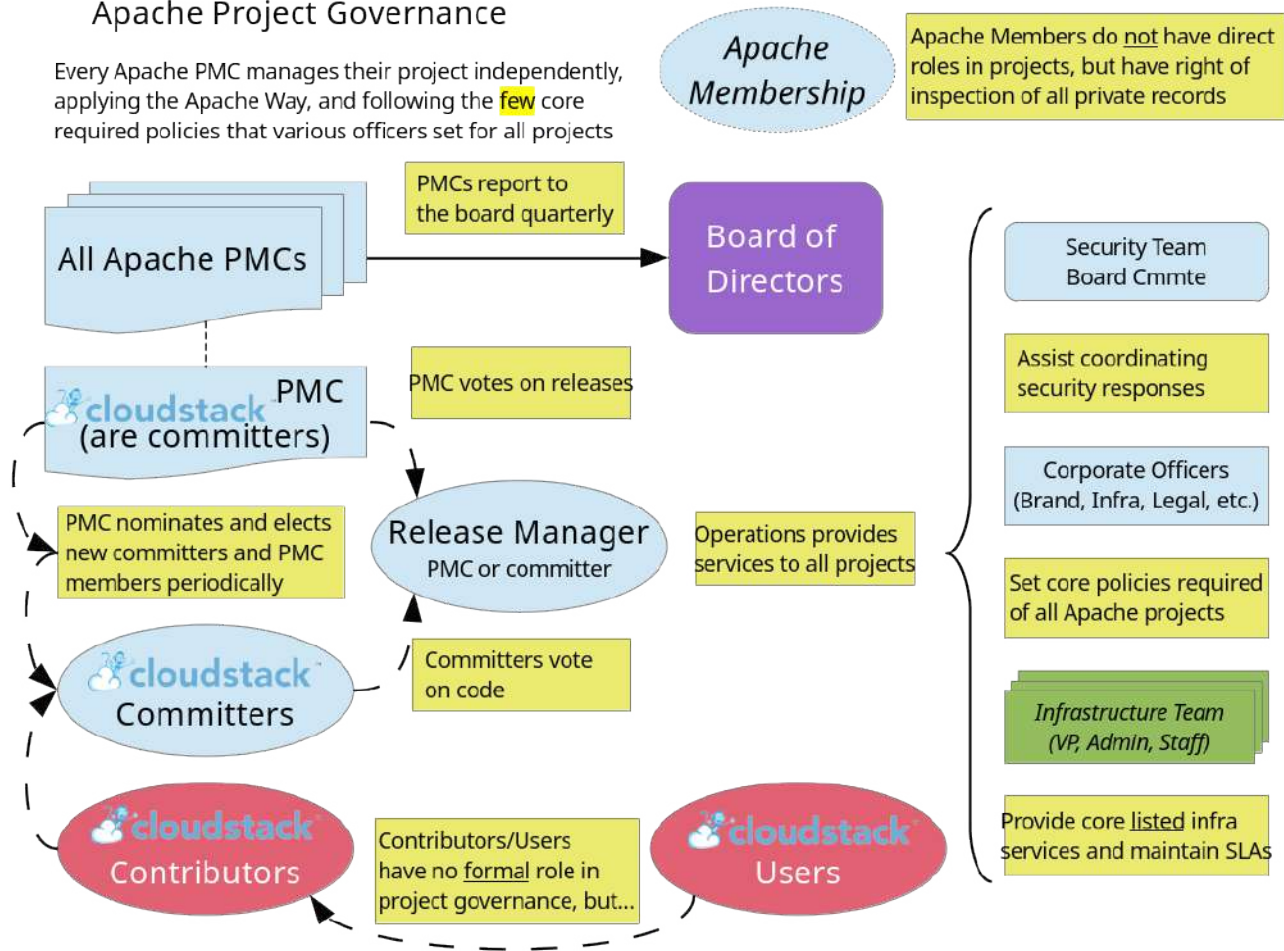
this means if you -1 you take on the responsibility to deal with your objection,

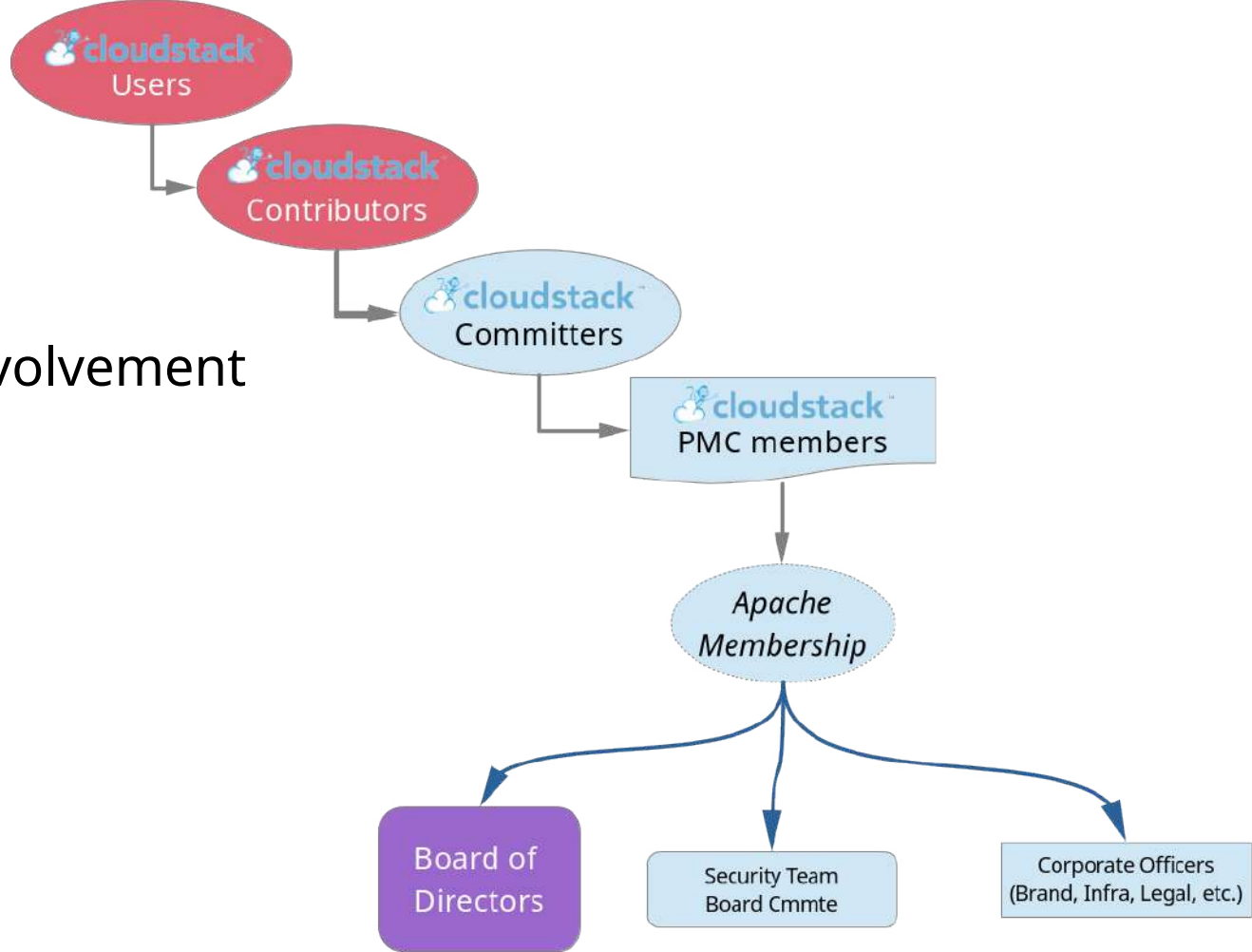

- logo/name (appropriation)

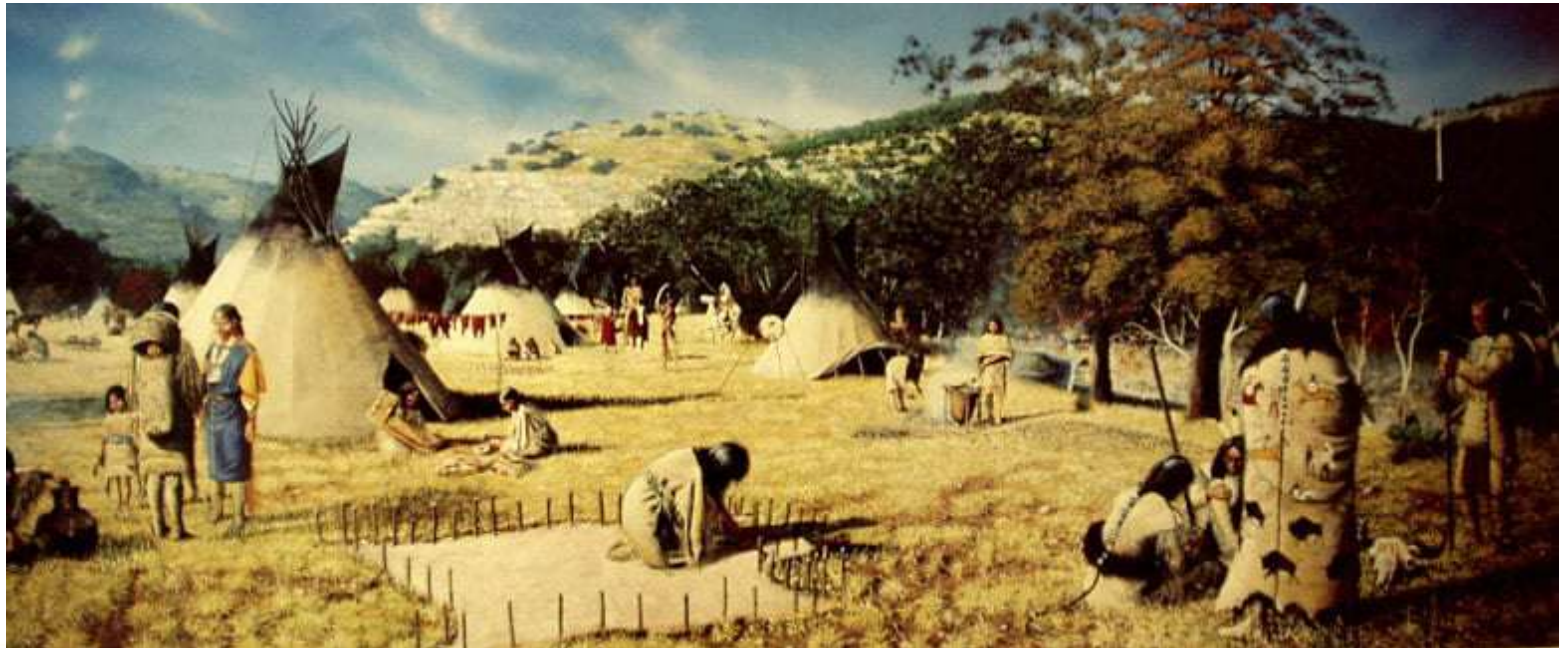
but also on project specifically:

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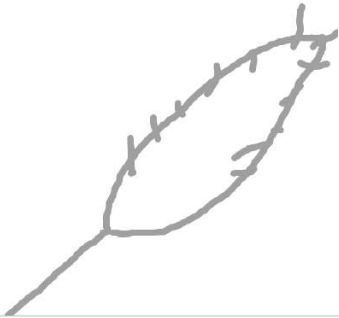

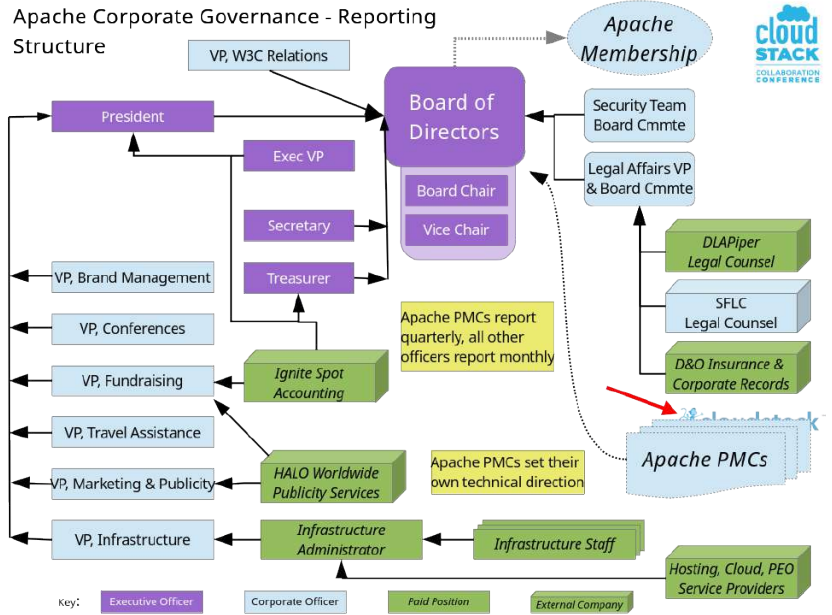

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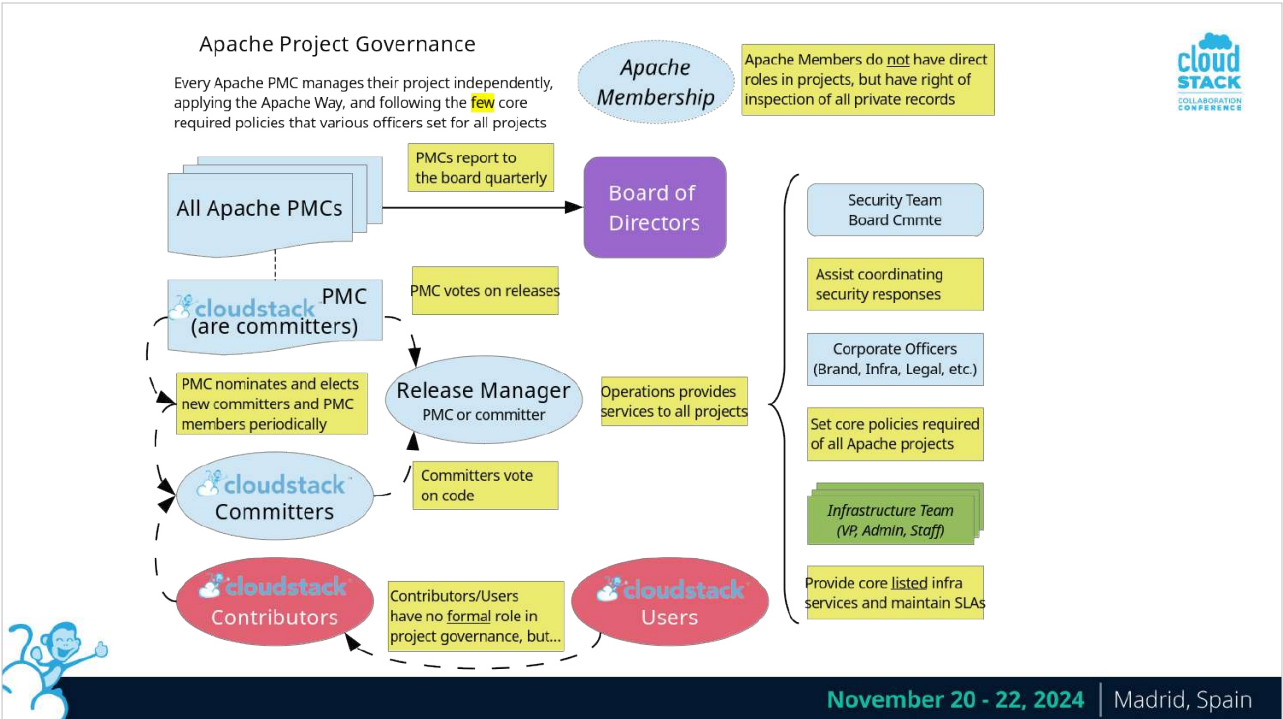
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when are binding votes needed

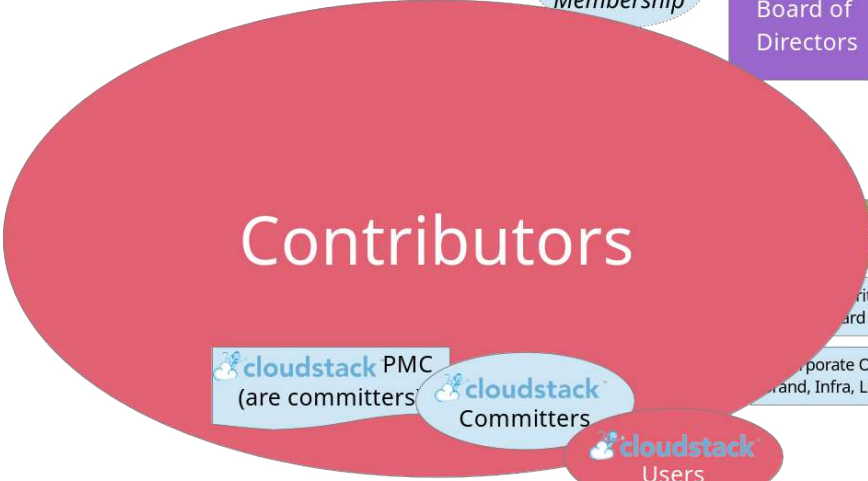

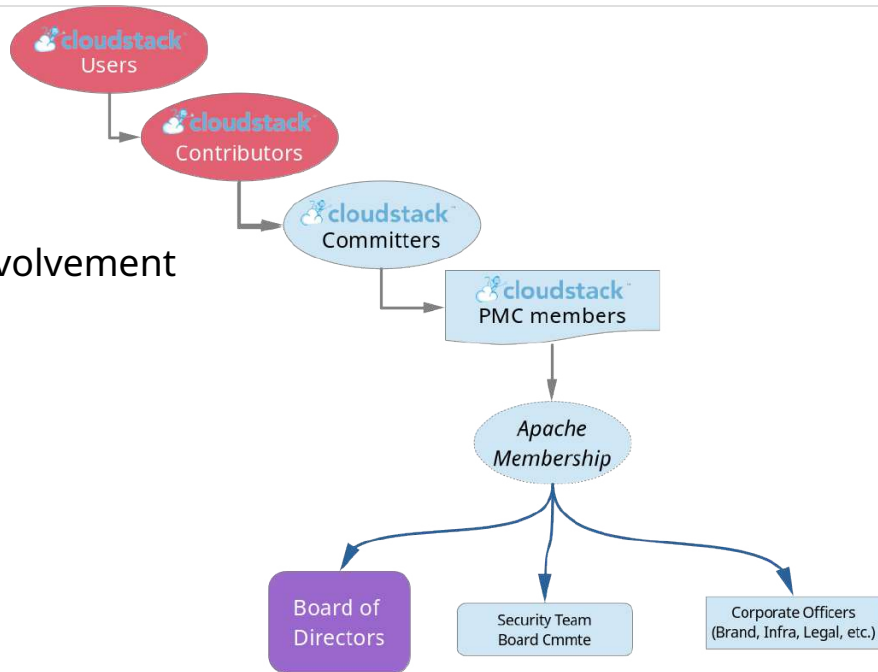
